

Grant County 2021 Equalization Meetings

Organized Townships, and Cities of: Carson, Elgin, Leith, & New Leipzig

Grant County's agricultural average price per acre, certified by the State Tax Department, went from \$369.16 in 2020 to \$378.21 in 2021, an increase of 2.47% overall for the county. The average cropland type soils for 2021 increased 2.96% and non-cropland type soils 6.08%. Each taxpayer has the right to appear before the appropriate board of review or equalization and petition for correction of the taxpayer's assessment.
