Grant County 2020 Equalization Meetings

Grant County's agricultural average price per acre, certified by the State Tax Department, went from \$352.48 in 2019 to \$369.16 in 2020, an increase of 4.73% overall for the county. The average cropland type soils for 2020 increased 4.53% and non-cropland type soils 5.5%

Each taxpayer has the right to appear before the appropriate board of review or equalization and petition for correction of the taxpayer's assessment.
